	Keynote: Future of Fleet Industry Fleet management is likely to be more tumultuous in the next decade than it has been in the last five. During his 35-year career as a transportation and fleet management consultant, Paul has worked with large and small fleets across a broad range of industries, particularly state and local government fleets. He has worked in more than 20 countries around the world, so his views on fleet management are not shaped only by what he sees happening in the US and Canada. In this session, Paul will talk about the implications for fleet owners and fleet management professionals of three key industry trends that will shape the future of fleet management: changes in automotive technology; changes in management and employee expectations created by advances in information technology; and the loss of institutional knowledge as veteran fleet managers retire and are replaced, in many cases, by management generalists who know what the acronym KPI – but not EGR – means.
