NAFA CAFM/CAFS Recertification Guidelines

Recertification is an important element for all professional certification programs. The requirements for NAFA Fleet Management Association's certification programs are as follows:

Certified Automotive Fleet Manager (CAFM) designation - 80 points within five years Certified Automotive Fleet Specialist (CAFS) designation - 50 points within five years

Program participants who wish to recertify must submit their data through the online recertification tool or submit this form. NAFA has identified a variety of educational endeavors and leadership activities through which the NAFA CAFM/CAFS certifications may be maintained. NAFA continuously reviews programs and activities to identify those that merit inclusion.

Effective Date

Each CAFM/CAFS reaches his/her recertification date on the 5th anniversary of their graduation date. For example, a graduate who took the examination in October 2015 and graduated in February 2016, will submit recertification information by February 2021. A reminder will be emailed to the graduate in January of the year they are due to recertify, however, all members are responsible for noting the expiry date of their certification. Upon recertification, the graduate will be sent a congratulatory letter and Certificate.

Lifetime Certification

Upon reaching age sixty (60) or formal retirement, an individual who holds a current CAFM or CAFS is eligible to be considered certified for life. NAFA requires that a Lifetime Recertification Request Form be submitted along with documentation showing proof of age before a Lifetime Certification Award is presented.

Procedures

NAFA will email notices in January to the last known address on record for each CAFM/CAFS reminding them of recertification requirements. Those who have not recertified by June will receive additional communication from NAFA's Certification Content Committee. All CAFM/CAFS participants must advise NAFA of any change of address. NAFA accepts no responsibility for undelivered mail or e-mail.

NAFA will accept completed recertification requests in advance of the due date, provided the form shows the required 80/50 points. The form, however, will not be reviewed until one month prior to the expiration date. If a CAFM/CAFS candidate earns more than the necessary 80/50 points during any 5-year interval, the additional points shall not count towards the next recertification period.

Fees

The NAFA Board of Directors establishes fees to cover expenses of the recertification process. For each five-year period of renewal, the appropriate fee will be payable with the submission of the CAFM/CAFS online form.

Loss of Certification

Individuals who do not acquire sufficient CAFM/CAFS maintenance points by the expiration date or approved extension date, or who fail to submit the form to NAFA will lose the right to use the CAFM/S designation.

Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed on an individual basis and requests for extensions can be submitted by email to the Certification Assistant. CAFM/CAFS graduates have a three-month grace period following the expiration deadline to get the recertification application submitted. If the CAFM/CAFS graduate has not replied by the end of this grace period, CAFM/CAFS certification will no longer be recognized.
