TEXAS CHAPTER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Texas Chapter of the Fleet Professionals Association (aka FleetPros, formerly RMFMA) is proud to present the guidelines and requirements for our Education Scholarship Program.

The total dollar amount available to award is \$8,000.00 per year. Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to two students for each Spring and Fall semesters, totaling \$4,000 per student.

We feel that this will assist many of our members in furthering their education. Scholarships are awarded for the advancement of education in automotive/heavy equipment technology, fleet management and fleet certifications.

The Fleet Professionals Association (aka FleetPros, formerly RMFMA) is a non-profit professional organization dedicated to the advancement of the fleet management industry.

To apply for a scholarship, applicants must complete all sections of the application, include requested documentation and submit before the deadline date(s). Scholarship applications are available online at http://www.fleetpros.org/, or by contacting the Texas Chapter Chair.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- Scholarship value: various requested increments.
- Application deadline: <u>April 15 (for Fall Semester) /October 15 (for Spring Semester)</u>, each year.
- Announcement of awards will be at the May Quarterly meeting and either the November Texas Equipment & Technology Show or the November Quarterly meeting.
- Scholarships will be awarded for continuing education courses in the fleet industry, fleet management, and fleet certification programs within the State of Texas:
 - Accredited community college, college or university.
 - o Automotive technical college.



- o Fleet Management Certification Program(s).
- Scholarship funds may be utilized for:
 - Tuition and certification fees.
 - o Books and supplies required for course.
 - o Enrollment
- Scholarship award(s) must be used within (2) two years from the date of the award letter.
- Scholarship award(s) will be sent directly to the educational institution and require proof of enrollment, course names, and an invoice issued by the institution.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Letter of recommendation from an instructor (if applicable) and employer.
- 2. Copies of any Fleet related award(s) or certificate(s).
- 3. If training and or certification completion is at a future date, please submit documentation.
- 4. Completed application.
